To be condemned means to be judged and found guilty. The opposite of condemned is justified. If a person is condemned, he will go to hell. If a person is not condemned, he is justified and will go to Heaven. Notice in this study that the Scriptures teach that those who have been saved will never be judged for their salvation.
